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Introduction

### INTRODUCTION

Presented herewith are the budget estimates for the French system for 1964.

### ACTIVITY FORECAST

Data of the estimated activity of the French system in 1964 are given in the diagrams at Annex C, together with the corresponding details for the previous years. The variations as compared with 1963 can be summarised as follows :

This forecast includes no data concerning civil movements.

### ORGANIZATION AND ESTABLISHMENT

The present budget proposals are based on an organization for the French Divisions very similar to that in 1963. As in previous years, a number of technical and administrative functions are centralised at the National Agency and head office of TRAPIL.

As in previous years also, no request has been made for the training of personnel for wartime. The establishment shown includes no personnel required specially for civil movements. The activation of the Octeville pumping station has necessitated the inclusion of the additional operators required. In addition, in Division 2, the creation of dog handler posts enables guarding to be carried out more economically with the abolition of civil guarding in the 3 depots. This has considerably reduced the request for appropriations in Item 06-6-1.

It should be noted that at Fos/s/Mer, in the majority of instances tankers were discharged on Saturdays and Sundays. The number of staff in post there is that necessary to carry out these operations during normal working hours as specified in the French legislation governing hours of work. If it is impossible to avoid frequent arrivals of tankers between Friday evening and Monday morning, additional staff may have to be requested.

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Introduction

OPERATIONAL EXPENSES

The operational expenses for 1964 amount to :

FF 17.940.800 against FF 16.125.312 (1)

approved for 1963, representing an increase of approximately 11,3%. This increase is chiefly due to higher expenditure in the following chapters :

(i) Chapter 01 - Personnel

Increase due to the general rise in basic salaries, allowances and social charges and to promotions within the various grades.

(ii) Chapter 04 - Travel

Increase in the number of journeys in Divisions 1 and 2 and raising of the railway tariffs and subsistence allowance.

(iii) Chapter 06 - Operating

Increase in the appropriations for heating in Divisions 1 and 2 in terms of the estimated consumption of heating oil and gas. Increase in the appropriations for guarding owing to the raising of the hourly tariff for civil guards. The criteria are the same as in 1963. A reduction in the estimates for the civil firm has been achieved by the project for employing 12 dog handlers in Division 2.

It should be noted that the build-up of stocks was not taken into consideration when evaluating the appropriations required for fuel and lubricants.

(iv) Chapter 07 - Maintenance

The increase in the appropriations is essentially due to the greater amount of periodical maintenance required to be carried out in the installations and to the estimates relative to spare parts and consumables. For these materials, account was not taken of the level of stocks.

Maintenance of access roads to the installations

A governmental "ordonnance" (No. 58.115 of 7.1.1959) stipulates that every time a local road is used by heavy vehicles, the firms responsible for this traffic are charged a special tax for the maintenance of the road in question, this tax being proportional to the damage caused.

The appropriations requested in 1963 for this purpose being blocked pending a decision as to who should pay the tax, the 1964 requests have been inserted "p.m.".

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(v) Chapter 08 - Transportation

The kilometric rate has risen from FF 0,32 to FF 0,36 and the number of kilometres has increased in step with the traffic and also on account of the activation of 2 new installations.

(vi) Chapter 09 - Administrative and technical services

The Committees have approved lump sums for the previous years, but have stipulated that for 1964 and subsequent years, the appropriations should be calculated in terms of the real expenses. Pending this evaluation, the appropriations covering administrative and technical services and TRAPIL fee have been inserted "p.m." in the present budget proposals.

CAPITAL EXPENSES

Whereas the appropriations approved for 1963 amounted to FF 2.349.800 (1), the total capital expenses recommended for 1964 amount to FF 689.700 of which :

(i) FF 504.900 are justified by operational necessity, comprising essentially, apart from various minor items, the following :

- 1 air compressor in Division 2
- 1 air compressor and 1 generating set in Division 3
- 1 cross-country vehicle in Division 1
- 1 cross-country vehicle in Division 3

(ii) FF 174.800 are justified by increased operational efficiency, comprising essentially the following items :

- Distance-reading gauges at FOS and CAMBRAI
- 1 set of portable radio equipment in Divisions 1 and 3
- 1 injection pump test bench in Division 3

Pro memoria

The following items have been included "pro memoria" in the present proposals:

- 01-8-7 Fiscal contribution on wages and salaries
- 07-1-3c Site maintenance (maintenance of access roads)
- 09-7 Administrative and technical services and TRAPIL fee
- 09-9-1 Taxes
- 09-9-3b Minor damage caused to third parties
- 12-2 Modifications to pipelines and pumping stations.  
The extension of the port Le Havre necessitates relocating the pipelines. Owing to the priority of assignment of the public property concerned, the Port of Le Havre authorities are entitled, under French Law, to demand that the relocation of the lines be carried out without charge to the port. Pending a decision in principle on the financial responsibility, the request has been inserted "p.m.".

NATIONAL AGENCY

The responsibilities and the establishment of the National Agency are the same as in 1963. The increase in appropriations is due solely to salary increases.

RECEIPTS

The question of accounting for minor receipts (sales of scrap, slop oils, etc.) not yet having been solved, it has been included "p.m.".

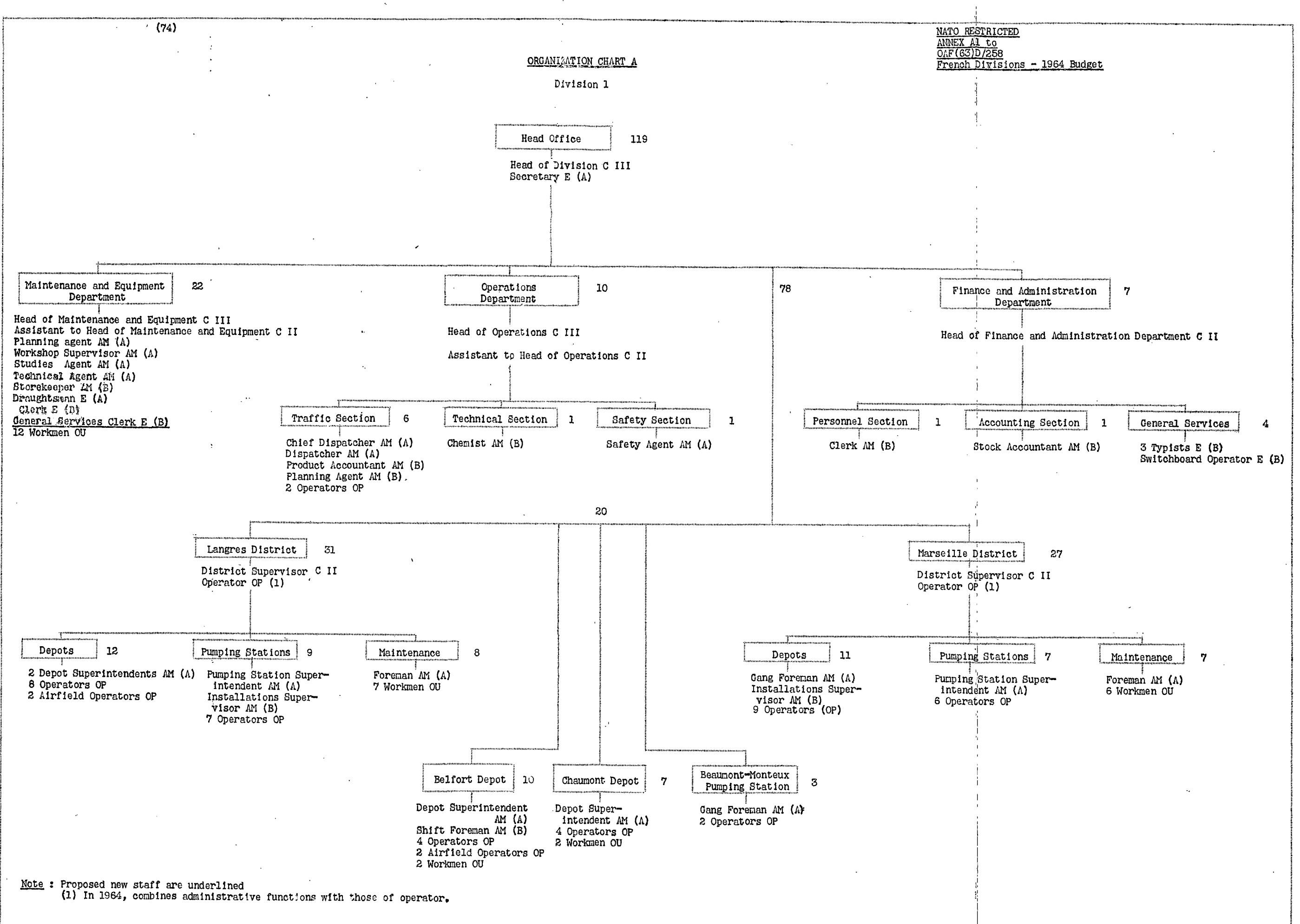

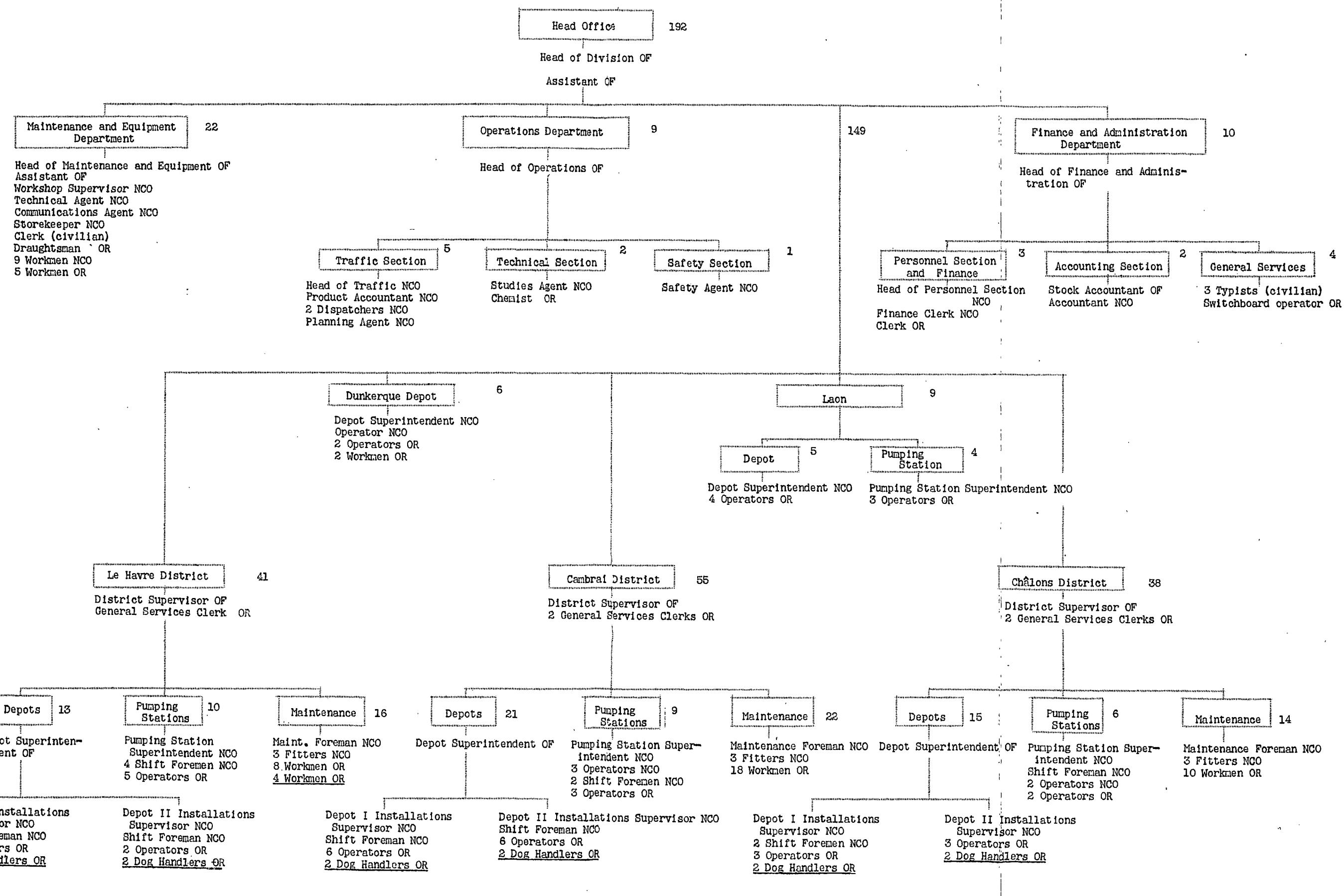

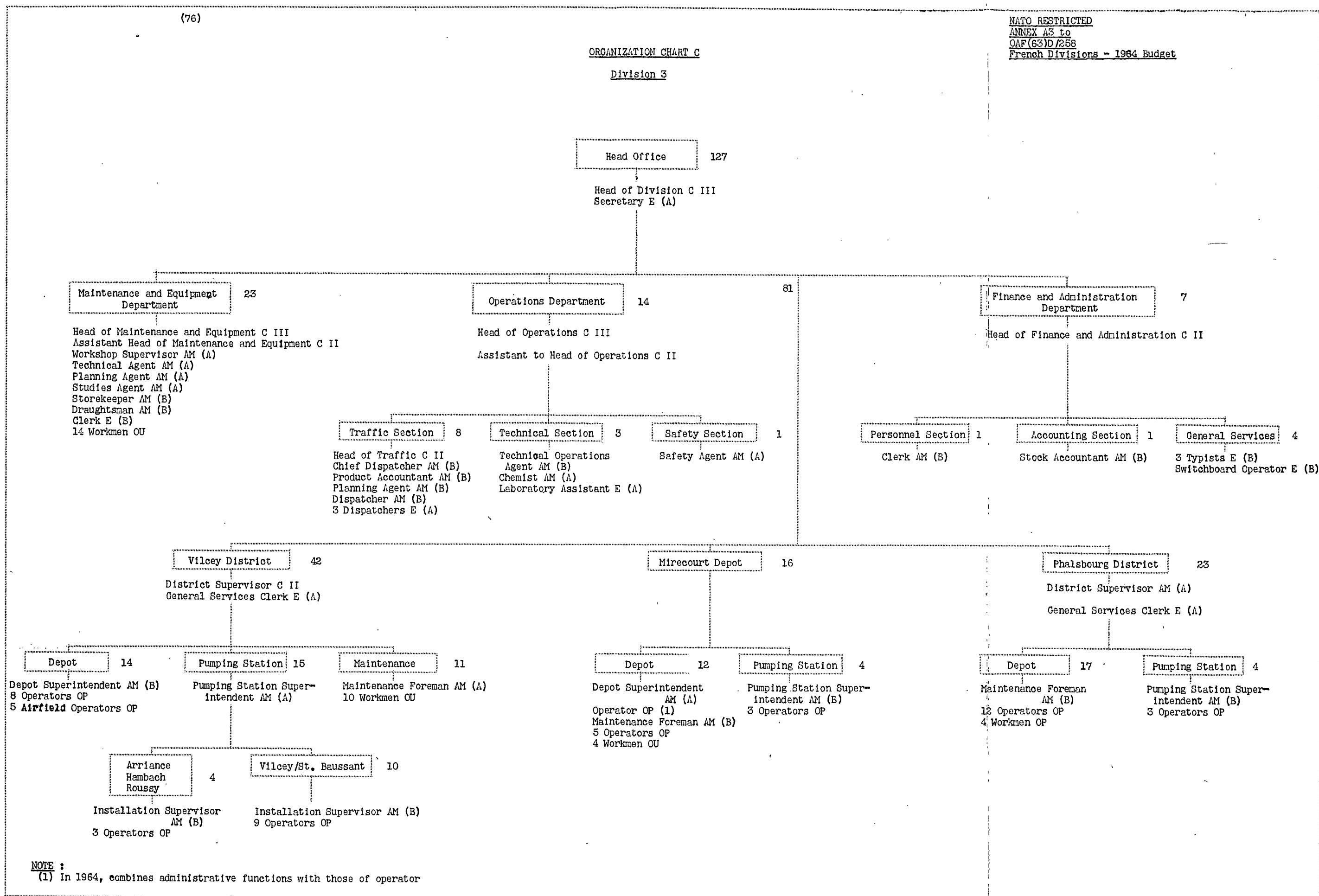
