

We have your letter of July 7th, 1961 and the Statement of Value and Relationship B for the late Ecloose from which it appears that he was survived by one son Dan who died in 1910 or thereabouts survived by no heirs. In view of this the land asset, namely, lot 109 held in the name of the late Ecloose under Location Ticket ~~109~~ reverted to the Band for lack of heirs and we will inform the Land Registrar to cancel the Location Ticket which will render the lot available for allocation. Please note the conclusion of this estate.

We enclose IA5-154 (B) for the Estate of the late Ecloose who died intestate apparently before 1900.

The sole asset in his Estate is Lot 109 Cowichan I.R. 1 which he held under L.T. 732, the Agency copy of which is enclosed.

As is the case with many of the Location Tickets on this Reserve, it seems probable that Ecloose was not the owner of the whole of the lot. In any event it seems that he disposed of most of his property during his lifetime and that at the time of his death he owned little or nothing of the lot. However, there is no documentary evidence of any sort to illustrate this (as usual).

Ecloose's sole heir was apparently his son Dan, who died in approximately 1910 with no heirs. Our Band records start in 1920 with a complete list of the entire Band in the handwriting of Mr. Robertson, the former Superintendent. We can state that the name of Ecloose does not appear on that list, which would seem to confirm that the entire family had died off, as seems to be the case with many of the old Koksilah Band families.

In the circumstances we therefore recommend that Lot 109 revert to Band ownership in the absence of any heirs.


