Watson habe.





This child was committed to the Alberta Institute for Girls on February 22, 1962. As at April 1st of this year, the costs of these placements in institutions outside Alberta are being charged back to the Territorial Welfare. Territorial Welfare will of course be charging back to us for those children of Indian status.

Prior to her committal, this girl was in the Whitehorse Hostel and had residence in the Yukon Territory.

In addition to the \$3.50 per day, there would of course be any other actual expenditures on behalf of the child.
