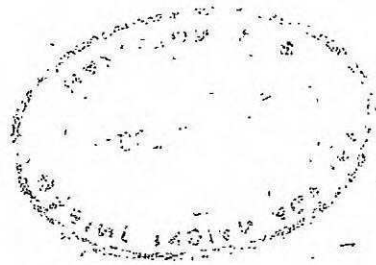
In reply to your letter of June 20th, 1957, in which you requested transfer of Moses Negap trapline to Alec Gunanoot, I wish to advise as follows.

Dear Mrs. Gunanoot;

Ottawa has ruled that the estate of the late Negap Moses shall be one half to yourself and one half to Sarah Negap.

The assets of this estate consist of :-

1. House and lot on th Kispiox Reserve situated between the properties of James Blackwater on the North and Thomas Sampson on the South.
2. Approximately six (6) acres of land on the Kispiox Reserve No. 3 on the East bank of the Kispiox River and on the North boundary of the reserve.

They further suggest that you may be willing to buy out Sarah Negap's half of the estate and if you are willing to do this they wish you to pay the money to Ottawa through this office. The total value of the estate comes to \$300.00, therefor the amount you would have to pay is \$150.00. If you do not wish to buy out Sarah Negap's half of the estate please inform this office and I will pass your decision on to Ottawa.

There is also the trapline registration, which belongs to Moses Negap, do you want to re-register this or do you wish to let it go to someone else ?

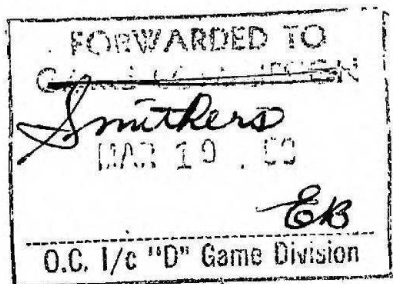

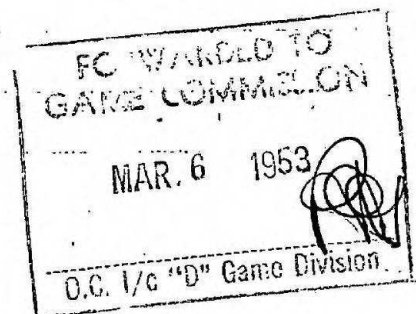

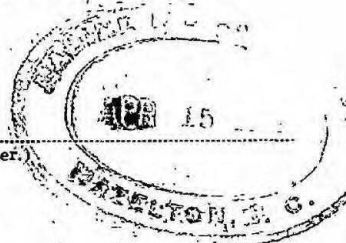
