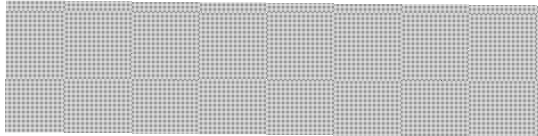

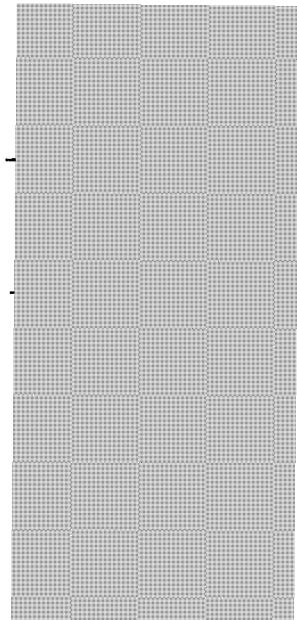

This will refer to your letter of March 16, concerning [REDACTED], who was removed from membership in the Brunswick House Band when she was declared enfranchised with [REDACTED] by Order in Council P.C. No. 1953-139 dated February 5, 1953 under the provisions of Section 108 (2) of the Indian Act.

Section 108 (2) of the Act as it read prior to its amendment of August 14, 1956 did not make specific reference to the enfranchisement of children of Indian women who married non-Indians. We have now been informed by the Deputy Attorney General that Section 108 (2) of the Act would not have applied to these children and that they would not have lost their Indian status as a result of the enfranchisement orders. Consequently, Dora Frog did not lose her Indian status and entitlement to be registered in membership in the Brunswick House Band as a result of the Order in Council dated February 5, 1953. [REDACTED] is therefore not entitled to the share of Band Funds and Annuity which would have been payable to [REDACTED] if [REDACTED] had lost her Indian status and membership in the Brunswick House Band and it would be appreciated if you would return the \$651.68 which was forwarded to you on March 23, 1953 to be held for [REDACTED] until such time as she attained [REDACTED] birthday. It would be most helpful if you could make the cheque payable to the Receiver General of Canada and forward it with the duplicate of this letter so that the funds may be readily identified.

I should mention at this time that we will shortly be requesting the return of the balance of funds you are holding for all children of women who married non-Indians and were declared enfranchised between September 4, 1951 and August 14, 1956. I have attached a list of these individuals and it would be appreciated if you would discontinue making further payments to them from the monies we forwarded to you. Incidentally, it would also be appreciated if you would provide us with the latest address you have of the persons listed so that

we may be able to write to them and explain the situation regarding their entitlement to band membership and why the funds are no longer payable to them.

I am extremely sorry for the inconvenience to you and your staff. However, I am sure you will appreciate how anxious we are to rectify this unfortunate error and clarify the entitlement of these people with the least possible delay.



A short time after that we sent you a cheque for \$651.68, being your share of the Brunswick House Band fund and then shortly after that, April 1st, 1953, you received a cheque for \$80.00, representing your share of treaty nine annuity payable because of your enfranchisement.

At that time we we advised you as follows, quote "A cheque for \$651.68, representing the child's share of the band fund, is being forwarded to the public trustee, Province of Ontario, for administration. The child's share of treaty money, in the amount of \$80.00 will be forwarded to the public trustee on April 1st, 1953" In other words you have received all the money that is payable to you [redacted]. Money is being held in trust, by the public trustee of the Province of Ontario.

I note in your letter that you tell me that if I do not do anything about this matter you are going to write to Ottawa about it. I might say you are completely at liberty to do so.

By reason of the marriage and in accordance with the provisions of the Indian Act, Dora Neff (nee Frog) and her [REDACTED] child, [REDACTED] were declared enfranchised by authority of Order in Council P.C. No. 1953-139 dated February 5, 1953, with the resultant effect that Dora Neff and her [REDACTED] child, [REDACTED] lost all rights as Indians.

By reason of the enfranchisement Dora Neff received her full per capita share of the Brunswick House Band Funds and Treaty 9 Annuity payable to her. The per capita share payable on account of the [REDACTED] child, [REDACTED] was deposited with the Public Trustee, Province of Ontario, Osgoode Hall, Toronto, Ontario, for his administration. Presumably the child is now in the custody and care of her mother, therefore, any request respecting these funds should be directed to that office.

Your letter of April 11th is acknowledged together with the attached statement of funds on record with your department as having been deposited with the Public Trustee. It is regretted that you were not favoured with an earlier reply. However, this has been occasioned by the fact that some of the accounts have been difficult to locate, due to these being known by other names, and that I have only had the opportunity of checking these from time to time.

A copy of the statement is returned. To the left of the child's name in most instances, you will note that we have placed a "o" or a "*", the "o" denoting that the funds are still in the office of the Public Trustee, and where the "*" is shown the funds have already been disbursed to the child in question, as he or she has already attained his or her twenty-first birthday and produced documentary evidence, usually in the form of a birth certificate, to substantiate the date of attaining his or her majority.

There are eight names on the list which to date I have been unable to locate; and any additional information that you might be able to give as to when these funds were received, any alternative names, or a copy of any receipt that you may have obtained from the office of the Public Trustee when these funds were forwarded, will be appreciated.

We note in your letter that you request we supply you with any current addresses. I would point out that in practically all cases, unless the recipient contacted our office prior to his attaining the age of twenty-one, we experienced considerable difficulty in locating them; and


their final address was usually obtained after three or four letters were forwarded to other members of the family or to solicitors who may have acted in other cases. You will therefore appreciate that we cannot give you current addresses for the cases where the moneys have not been distributed as a result of the child not having to date attained his twenty-first birthday.

We would also point out that the surnames as shown on the list were not always the surnames that we eventually were able to contact the child by. In the Dokis estate, the surname was established as "Serre". The Chicago children were known as "Boucher"; the Peters by the name of "Lacombe"; some of the Gray children by "Engelgau". Before any distribution was made in these cases, these differences were established by affidavit and the relative birth certificates. In view of these differences in name, you will appreciate that we have experienced considerable difficulty in dealing with these enfranchised moneys.

We sincerely trust that the aforementioned will bring you up-to-date as to what we have been doing. On receipt of your request for the return of the moneys, as you have indicated you will be doing, we will be pleased to forward a cheque for the moneys on hand for the various estates; but you will appreciate that we cannot refund moneys where we have already distributed the shares to the children.

Any assistance that you can give in helping us locate the eight names beside which no "o" or "*" appears would be appreciated.
