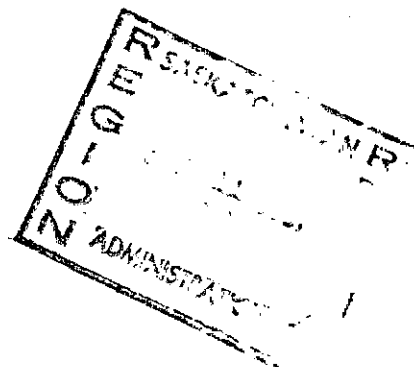

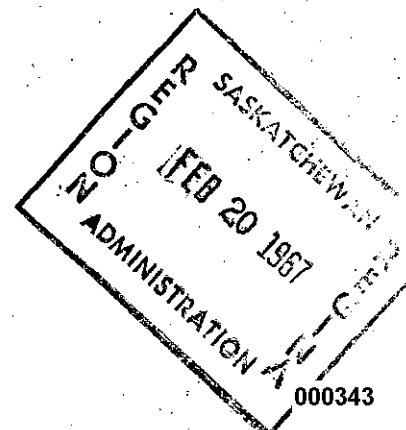

Mr. [REDACTED] who is one of the best farmers in this Agency, reported to the Agency Office November 8, 1963, that he will be unable to meet his financial commitments this year. His crop and some livestock were destroyed to a considerable extent by hail and a miniature tornado.

Mr. [REDACTED] showed us a P.F.A. report dated October, 1963 substantiating the facts. The following are statistics:

Mr. [REDACTED] lost 40 turkeys in the tornado. He has 24 head of cattle, 400 turkeys, eleven pigs and 70 chickens. This livestock will support his income, in part, this winter.

Mr. [REDACTED] is saving wheat and oats for seed but will need farm assistance in Spring, 1964, to put in his new crop. He has applied for P.F.A.

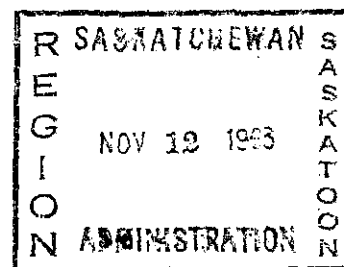

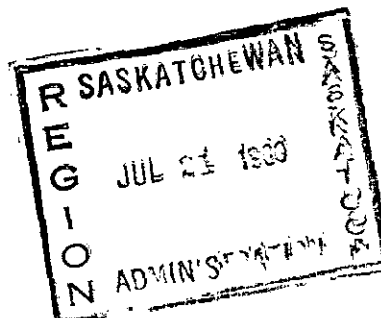
He is interested in getting into more cattle as he feels this will stabilize his farming operation and will carry him over in case of a crop failure.

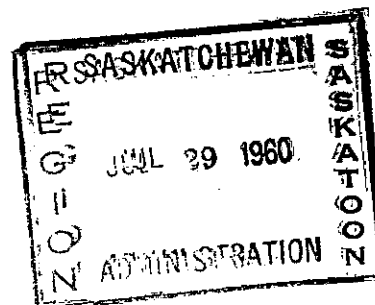



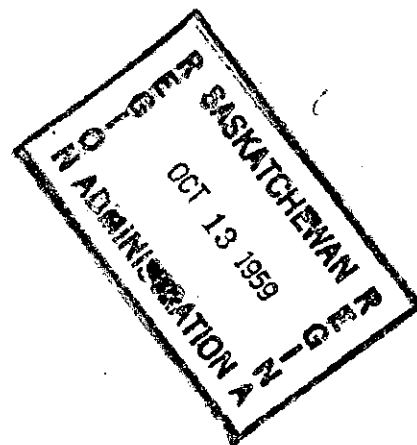
