

1. It is understood that no action has been taken at Base level to recover the cost of services described in reference A and provided to the noted institutions.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of DNDP 55, your Base was provided in reference B with authority to recover these costs through the medium of National Defence Invoices (form DND 506) as described in CFAO 231-6. It is requested that this action be initiated.

3. Your attention is also drawn to reference C which requested that your Base renegotiate the agreements with these institutes to include a labour rate of \$18.27 per hour (vice \$12 per hour) and a 10% surcharge on both parts and labour (vice parts alone). It is realized that this direction was provided too late to be incorporated in agreements covering the Jan-Mar 78 period, however future services should be covered by the renegotiated agreements.

4. The additional administrative burden of recovering costs using DND 506 forms is appreciated; however, it is considered that this system is less onerous than raising separate agreements each time in accordance with DNDP 55.



- (b) The student will be able to select the most appropriate tactical formation for the containment and control of a disruptive situation.

Outcome

- (a) Given a schematic drawing of six tactical formations the student will label each tactical formation.
- (b) Given three hypothetical scenarios the student will select the tactical formation which is best suited to the control and containment of the situation.

Sample Criterion Test

- (a) Label the Schematic drawing of the tactical formation in blank space provided below the chart.

Following the presentation on the principles of crowd control and the various tactical formations which can be employed, the instructor should distribute the self administered criterion test for tactical formations. In terms of the hypothetical scenarios the instructor may wish to describe to the class the three scenarios and allow the student to select the most appropriate formation for all the given scenarios before reviewing their responses and providing the correct answers.

MOVEMENT AND DEPLOYMENT

RIOT CONTROL FORMATION DRILL

Reference: A. CFP 302(8) Part Two, Sect 4, Para 219-230
for background information

1. The use of organized formations against rioters, as opposed to allowing a general skirmish to occur between staff members and rioters, has many advantages. It is also in keeping with the following basic Principles of Crowd Control.

- a. The Selection and Maintenance of an Aim. All efforts can be concentrated on achieving a required result.
- b. Maintenance of Morale. The knowledge that they are acting together as a trained and efficient force will help the morale of the members. Conversely, the mere sight of a disciplined opposition can be enough to discourage spectators from becoming active participants in a riot.
- c. Concentration of Force. Victory is the result of concentration of superior force at the decisive point.
- d. Economy of Effort. The results obtained by a body of trained men, acting together, are greater than those achieved by a similar number of individuals, acting individually.
- e. Security. Each member of a formation protects, and is protected by the remainder.
- f. Flexibility. Formations can be rapidly changed to meet varying situations.
- g. Co-operation. The team spirit of a formation which has trained together is an important factor towards success.
- h. Administration. Administrative problems, such as ammunition re-supply and feeding, are greatly used.


SECTION FORMATIONS

2. a. Section Line

- (1) Command - "No 1 Section - Section Line - Move".

- 2 -

- (2) Action - No 2 stands fast, or moves to the position designated by the Section Leader. The remainder align themselves on the left of No 2 and automatically takes up their dressing. The Section Leader takes a position behind No 6 man, and if armed with a rifle, he shall remain at the "port arms" position.




- (3) Line Signals

- (a) Visual. Raise both arms to the side until horizontal; arms and hands extended, palms down.
- (b) Audio. Orally with or without the loudhailer, or one short whistle.

b. Section Wedge.

- (1) Command. "No 1 Section - Section Wedge - Move".
- (2) Action. No 6 stands fast, or moves to the position designated by the Section Leader. The remainder align themselves on the right and left side of No 6 and automatically take up their dressing. The Section Leader takes a position behind No 6 man, and if armed with a rifle, he shall remain at the "port arms" position.



- (3) Wedge Signals

- (a) Visual. Extend both arms downwards and to the sides at an angle of 45 degrees; arms and hands extended with palms down.
- (b) Audio. Orally with or without the loudhailer, or two short whistles.




c. Section Echelon

- (1) Command - "No 1 Section - Section Echelon Left or Right - Move".
- (2) Action - On echelon left, No 2 stands fast, or moves to the position designated by the Section Leader. The remainder align themselves on the left and on an angle to the rear. On echelon right, No 10 stands fast, or moves to the position designated by the Section Commander. The remainder align themselves on the right and on an angle to the rear. The Section Leader takes position behind No 6 man, and if armed with a rifle, he shall remain at the "port arms" position.



(3) Echelon Left Signals

- (a) Visual. Extend the right arm upwards and to the side at an angle of 45 degrees, the left arm will be extended downwards and to the side at an angle of 45 degrees, fingers extended.
- (b) Audio. Orally with or without the loudhailer, or two long whistles.

(4) Echelon Right Signals

- (a) Visual. Extend the left arm upwards and to the side at an angle of 45 degrees, the right arm will be extended downwards and to the side at an angle of 45 degrees, with fingers extended.
- (b) Audio. Orally with or without a loudhailer, or one long whistle.

d. Advance

- (1) Visual. Raise the right arm vertically above the head, and make a "follow me" motion, by moving the hand downwards, palm down. This will be done twice, the formation will step off on completion of the second downward movement of the hand.
- (2) Audio. Orally with or without a loudhailer, or three short whistles.

e. Halt

- (1) Visual. Raise the right arm vertically above the head, palm forward. The formation will halt when the hand is dropped.
- (2) Audio. Orally with or without the loudhailer, or a continuous series (not less than six) of short whistles.

PLATOON FORMATIONS

3. a. General

- (1) Each platoon should normally consist of three sections and a HQ.
- (2) The Platoon HQ should normally consist of the following:
 - (a) Platoon Commander;
 - (b) Platoon WO;
 - (c) Marksman;

Following the presentation of the subject matter the instructor may draw a floor plan of a building on the chalk board. SEARCH AND ASSAULT

SEARCHING BUILDINGS

SEARCHING

1. There is considerable risk to ERT members when searching buildings. This is particularly true when there is an escapee or rioter in the building. The use of CN gas may well be the safest method of forcing an escapee or rioter from a building. When using CN gas to force an escapee or rioters from a building the following factors must be considered:

- a. Gas should not be introduced into the building in lethal quantities. There is a possibility that there may be innocent inmates in the building. There may also be innocent staff members or hostages in the buildings.
- b. The inmate may be in possession of a respirator. The introduction of gas would not have the expected effect, and therefore should not be completely relied upon.

2. Entry. Entry to the building will be made by pairs of mutually supporting ERT members. An entry point will be established to ensure that others do not enter at any other point, thereby creating confusion with searchers already in the building. If possible all other entry or exit points, except the exit to the "arrest zone", should be locked.

3. Fanout. Before pairs of ERT members enter a building they will be assigned to a specific area within the building that they will be required to search. ERT members will fanout in pairs to their respective areas and search toward the exit to the "arrest zone".

4. Search. The conduct of the search will depend on what is being sought. The following procedures should be applied:

- a. Searching for Inmates. A careful cursory check of each room or possible hiding place should be made by one member of the search team. The second member of the team will keep his partner covered in case of a surprise attack.
- b. Searching for Destructive Devices or Contraband. All areas of the building must be thoroughly searched when searching rooms a detailed systematic search must be conducted. Starting at the door the searchers may move around the room in a clockwise direction, thoroughly searching everything from the floor area to half-way up the wall. Upon arriving back at the door they will again go around the room thoroughly searching from half-way up the wall to and including the ceiling area.

5. Assistance to Search Party. Before searching a building, a floor plan of the building should be obtained if at all possible. Persons who are familiar with the building, such as Works Department or people who normally occupy the building, should accompany the search party. These personnel can provide the following services to the searchers:

- a. Entrance to locked rooms.
- b. Operation of building facilities.
- c. Familiarity with building enabling identification of objects foreign to the building.



1. The proposed blanket agreement for the provision of Land Maintenance Services to Federal Penitentiaries, submitted to your Base under cover of reference A, was also staffed to NDHQ DFinS for comment.

2. References B and C provide NDHQ DFinS approval of the proposed agreement subject to the following changes:

- a. Para 3 - Recovery action must be taken no less than quarterly;
- b. Para 3 a - Cost of labour to be recovered must be in accordance with the DND Cost Factors Manual. This is currently \$18.27 per hour (excluding 10% surcharge see below) based on a corporal's salary. This figure will have to be reconfirmed each year there is a general military pay increase; and
- c. Para 3 c - The 10% surcharge must apply to both parts (if DND supplied) and labour.

3. It is requested that your Base incorporate the above changes in your agreements with the various penitentiaries in your area. It is hoped that the proposed implementation date will remain 1 Apr 78. Should this not be possible, or if you have already negotiated the contract based on the proposed agreement provided in reference A, advise this Headquarters accordingly and subsequent direction will be provided.





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

Mr Luciani of DSVEM, who is the OPI responsible for lighting systems at NDHQ, advises that at present there is no auxiliary lighting system which could be used as discussed at ref A; however, 20 self-contained floodlight systems Ref #6230-00-181-2498 which consist of two 1,000W search lights on a telescope tower that can be extended to 33 ft mounted on a trailer have just been purchased. Twelve are being deployed to Air Bases and eight are being sent to 202 Workshop Depot in Montreal for modification to increase the lighting capacity. On completion of the mod which will take approximately 3 months, three will be deployed to Petawawa which can be made available for auxiliary lighting assistance to federal penitentiaries.







During the DCOS TS annual staff visit to CFB Kingston in Sep, it was observed that BMS(L) were repairing weapons for local penitentiaries but were not requesting financial recovery in accordance with reference B. The requirement for separate agreements for each repair and the volume of repairs completed made recovery action too cumbersome.


2. To rectify the above situation, this HQ recommends the following:

- a. that a blanket agreement be negotiated with each supported penitentiary (see Annex A as an example);
- b. that recovery action be on a quarterly or semi-annual basis as desired by the negotiating penitentiary;
- c. that a discrete CF 1020 be used as the executive document for each repair request (the 1020 can be prepared by base, but must be signed by an authorized penitentiary representative);
- d. that DND 506 National Defence invoices be raised at Base level in accordance with references C and D to recover costs (recovery in this case will be by the inter-departmental Settlement Advice System); and
- e. that costs be based on \$12 per hr plus parts costs (if not provided by the penitentiary) and a 10% surcharge for parts procured by DND.





4. On 27 Oct the team was employed from 0800 - 1600 hrs with the following replacements:

- a. [REDACTED] Capt AR Rent replaced Maj Tappin; and
- b. [REDACTED] Pte MA Kitchen replaced Cpl Falardeau.

ACTION TAKEN

5. Major Tappin met with Mr Dowsett, the Penitentiary Director, to discuss the required task. In addition, Maj Tappin and Sgt McBride were briefed by Mr Turner the Security Officer as to details of the search. Only the main exercise yard was to be searched. The smaller "court yards" were not requested to be searched as they contained a great deal of debris from the recent disturbance.

6. The team was armed with 9mm pistols and utilized three Detector Sets, Mine, No C4. The team was broken into three search groups, each consisting of a detector operator and a "digger". Digging tools were provided by the penitentiary staff. The officer and NCO laid out the search lanes to ensure the entire area was swept, controlled the teams, and viewed each "find". Two penitentiary guards accompanied the team. During the two days, the team members were not at any time in close proximity to the inmates.

7. Although no "weapons" as such were found, a considerable amount of metal (approximately 500 lbs) ranging in size from nails to ancient farming implements and a quantity of metal ore bearing rock was unearthed. It was decided to dig in each case when an indication of buried metal was detected. This was done to clean up the area for possible future similar search teams and to ensure that all detector responses were appropriately checked. All recovered material was removed by the accompanying guards.

SUPPORT

9. The team was transported in a nine passenger station wagon provided by GFB Kingston. A total of 84 miles was put on the vehicle.

10. Meals were provided by the penitentiary and were taken in the staff dining room.

CONCLUSION


11. In view of the large areas that require sweeping at the Millhaven Institution, experience has shown that the three Detector Sets held by this unit are not adequate to conduct the complete task in an efficient manner. If it is anticipated that this task is likely to be a continuing requirement, it is recommended that consideration be given to increasing the unit detector holdings to a minimum of six sets.
