Dear Jack Tashoots,

I send you four copies of your Tashoots Family Trapgrounds- they are all exactly the same, give some to your brothers so that they see good. Your Tashoots Family is as follows.

Tashoots Jack wife-2 youngsters.
----- Edwin wife & 2 daughters.
----- Frank & wife.
----- Widow with William 34. Earl 20. & Mary
who has 3 children.

You see that you are quite a few- but if you all do the right thing- look after this ground and grow Beaver, it will produce well over a thousand dollars a year- only you HAVE TO MAKE IT DO THIS. Some job.

Cut it up as you like and I must see each man myself to know from him if correct or not.

One thing more. More talk is around about this big roadway from Vancouver up through this country. That means lots of white men, and they want trap grounds- you know that- My talk to you folk once more is to build yourself --- Cabins on your trap grounds - that shows its your own country - tents don't do that.

As requested, herewith is a good map of the Tashoots Family Trapping Ground. It is for all the above Family - it belongs to any and all.

It is quite big enough to keep you all during the winter if you look after it, and don't get any freinds to come along and catch fur - such as Dick Campbell and Peter Ware.

If you do get other Indians in and catch your fur - you will get no more help from this Office.

Now if your family wish to cut this ground up into your own seperate trap-grounds - you can do so - BUT you have not got to do so.

If you do want to - then each person draw a map and show what he wants, and sign it also, and all the maps must when put together make up this big map.

This si all I tell you- do as you like - but if you get outsiders inthere trapping and don't use the ground yourself ten other Indians or white men will want it - and most likely get it also.

Build your cabins at good places and look out for the Iskut bottom end of your ground - as White men go up there.

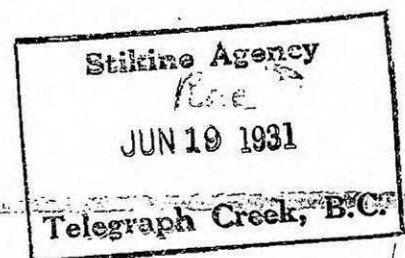
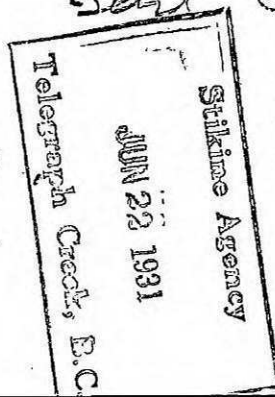
