Introduction

INTRODUCTION

Presented herewith are budget estimates for the German Divisions and the FBG Head Office for 1964.

ACTIVITY FORECAST

Data of estimated traffic and divisional activity in 1964 are given in the diagrams at annexes C and D, together with the corresponding details for previous years.

In Division 6 the quantity of inputs in m³, equal to off-takes, will increase by about 19% over 1963, mainly caused by higher deliveries to the US Hüttenheim pipeline.

In Division 7 the forecasted traffic in m³/km will increase by about 14% over 1963 taking into account a higher number of reverse pumping operations, when supplying depot Altenrath. The total input, equal to off-takes, has not changed. No account has been taken of the possible civil use in 1964, as the level of this activity cannot yet be determined.

ORGANIZATION AND ESTABLISHMENT

The personnel establishment of the Bad Godesberg Head Office has not changed since the 1963 budget, except for an "Assistant to the Head of Finance and Administration", who has been included and recommended. The Assistant is mainly required to release the Head of Finance and Administration from the pressure of work. In addition, the inclusion of the Assistant will allow the deletion of RM 6.000 approved in the 1963 budget for legal services, rendered by the parent company and of the post of an Internal Auditor, which was included as p.m. in the 1963 budget. Furthermore, it will then be possible to perform such tasks, which could not be executed up to now, because of the pressure of work in the Finance and Administration Office, such as the improvement of existing systems and methods in the administrative field, the reorganization of the accounting system, the establishment of Infrastructure inventories, etc.

There are two reasons for the deletion of the "Internal Auditor" shown in the 1963 budget as p.m. :

Firstly, the presence of the new assistant enables FBG to establish an adequate system of internal control in application of article 45.1 of Financial Regulations;

secondly, it is the intention that the adequate internal audit as per article 45.2 will be farmed out to the auditing company, which in any case is auditing FBG in conformity with its legal status. As the question of eligibility of the cost of this type of audit still depends from a decision to be taken by CEPPC, the appropriate request has been included as p.m. under item 09-9-3 of the 1964 budget.

The other p.m. post in the 1963 budget, the "Emergency Training Officer" is no longer included in the 1964 budget, since it is now clear that the tasks performed by the agent are mainly national ones. Common funding can therefore not be recommended.

Introduction

The main change in the 2 divisions is the entry into service of 2 new depots and 1 pumping station, i.e. depot Bocholt in Division 7 as from 1st March 1964 and depot Tuebingen with pumping stations Elsaweg and Kehl in Division 6 as from 1st October 1964. The number, functions and grades of the staff requested for these installations is exactly in line with the standard applied in the other German depots and stations. The personnel expenses are calculated as from the above mentioned dates only.

The request for fuel and lubricating oil (item 06-1) includes the anticipated consumption in 1964, but does not take account of the existing stocks. The quantities to be purchased will finally be influenced by recommendations to be made by AFCENT regarding the level of stocks necessary.

As in previous years, the expenses recommended in this budget exclude all those covering the training of personnel for wartime.

OPERATIONAL EXPENSES

The operational expenses for 1964 amount to :

DM 6.046.600 against DM 5.510.400

approved for 1963. This rise of about 10% is due chiefly to higher personnel expenses (Chapter 01); furthermore, there are increases on the one hand and decreases on the other hand in various other chapters as follows :

(i) Chapter 01 - Personnel

The increase of personnel expenses is caused by the staff to be engaged for the new installations and by the general rise in wages and salaries following a new tariff agreement and children's allowance and local bonus due to a change of governmental regulations. The increase in overtime, the other allowances, social insurance and benefits correspond to the increase in salaries and wages.

(ii) Chapter 04 - Travel

The increase is due to the rise in subsistence allowance, paid in connection with the new depots Bocholt and Tuebingen.

(iii) Chapter 06 - Operating

The increase is due to additional cost of electricity, heating oil, rent of telephone and teleprinter lines of new installations; furthermore due to the rise in labour cost of guarding contractors. On the other hand, the request for fuel has been decreased based on the actual consumption in 1962.

(iv) Chapter 07 - Maintenance

The decrease is due to the reduction of flying hours for the survey of the pipeline obtained by more economic routing and of the amount of anti-freeze and fire-fighting materials required.

(v) Chapter 08 - Transportation

The decrease is mainly caused by the exclusion of weighing charges for rail tank cars loaded at Contwig.

Introduction

In respect of provisions to cover work of an exceptional nature, amounting in total to DM 58.100 especially in chapters 06-8, (Miscellaneous operating Expenses) and 07-1-2/3a (Provisions for non-routine repairs/damage), it should be noted that the majority will only be committed when unforeseen incidents arise and exceptional repairs have to be undertaken.

CAPITAL EXPENSES

The total Capital Expenses recommended for 1964 amount to :

DM 338.100 (1) (against DM 612.000 in 1963)

- (i) of which :
- DM 313.700 are justified by operational necessity, comprising, apart from various minor items, essentially the following :
- (a) The outfit of new installations with machinery, laboratory, fire-fighting and safety equipment, dog compounds, tools, station wagons, office machinery, furniture, shelves for spare parts and canteen equipment. The assets requested are in line with the standards of outfits of other depots and stations.
- (b) A lorry, provided with a snow plough for pumping station Elsaweg with a garage. The lorry, which will normally serve as utility vehicle for the station is required to have access to the station also during winter time.
- (ii) - DM 5.300 are justified by increase of operational efficiency and include a hose cart for the tank cleaning crew and tachometer course recorders for lorries.
- (iii) - DM 19.100 are designed for replacement, comprising 2 station wagons and office equipment.

Included in the Capital Expenses, justified by operational necessity (i), is an amount of DM 99.600 as a provision for minor modifications and equipment which might be required in the course of the year and for which the procedure specified in AC/120-D/108 will be followed.

The following capital projects have been included as "p.m." for the German Divisions :

- (a) (13-1) Sludge destruction equipment.
Considerable reduction of transportation cost could be obtained, if the contaminated mud of tanks to be cleaned could be burnt at the depots. The outlay of the equipment is under review.

- (b) (12-2) Completion of installation of meters at airbases near the Markelo-Bramsche-Oldenburg pipeline. Final decision is still awaited which airbases are to be connected and where the meters will be installed.
- (c) (17-1) Office machines : the existing accounting machine at Bad Godesberg Head Office is to be replaced. The question is under study.

RECEIPTS

The estimated receipts for 1964 viz. DM 114.600 against DM 124.200 for 1963 show a decrease due to a reduction of services rendered for the procurement of the 90 days stock of spare parts on behalf of national Infrastructure authorities, which is partly balanced by additional services rendered to national airbases.

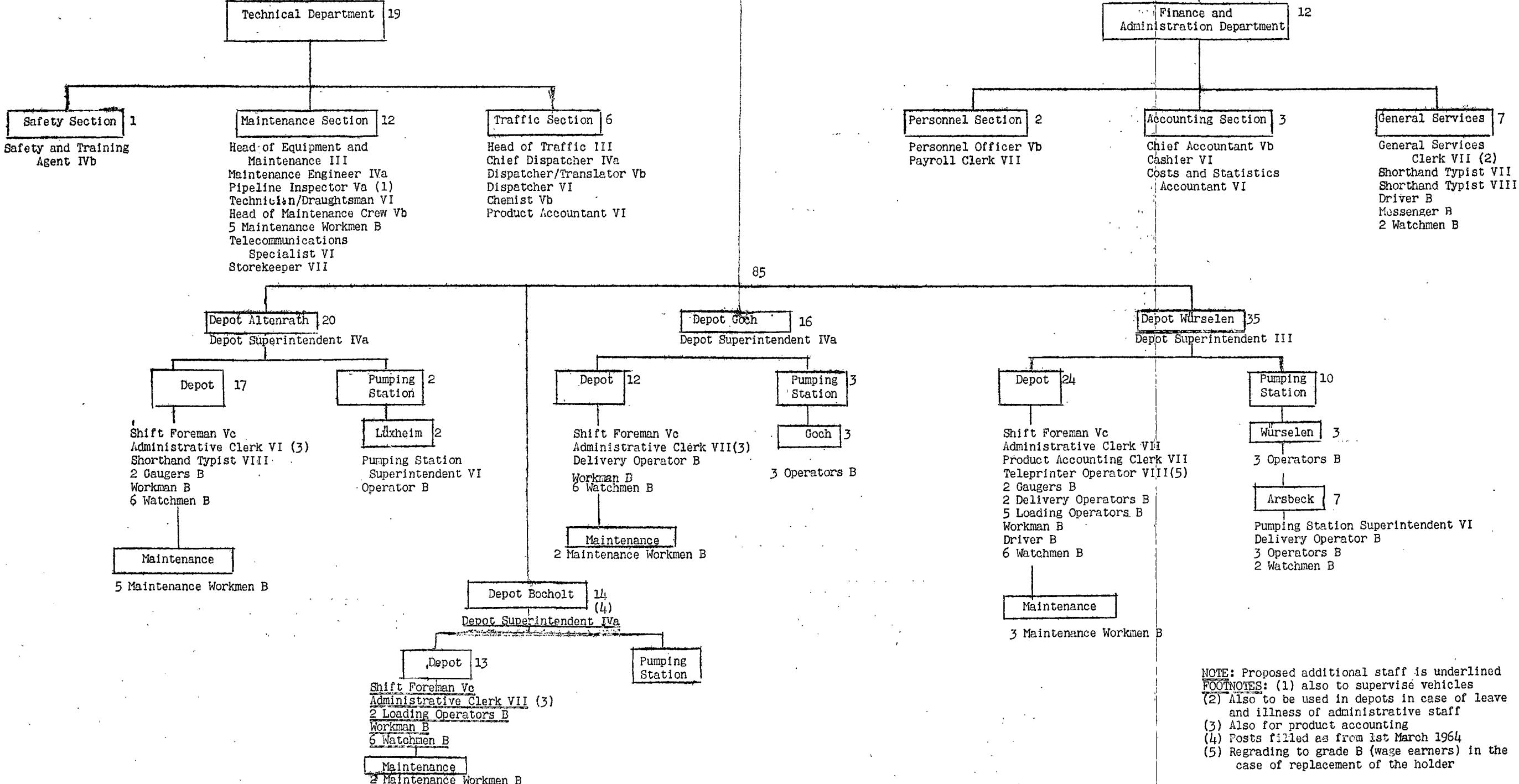

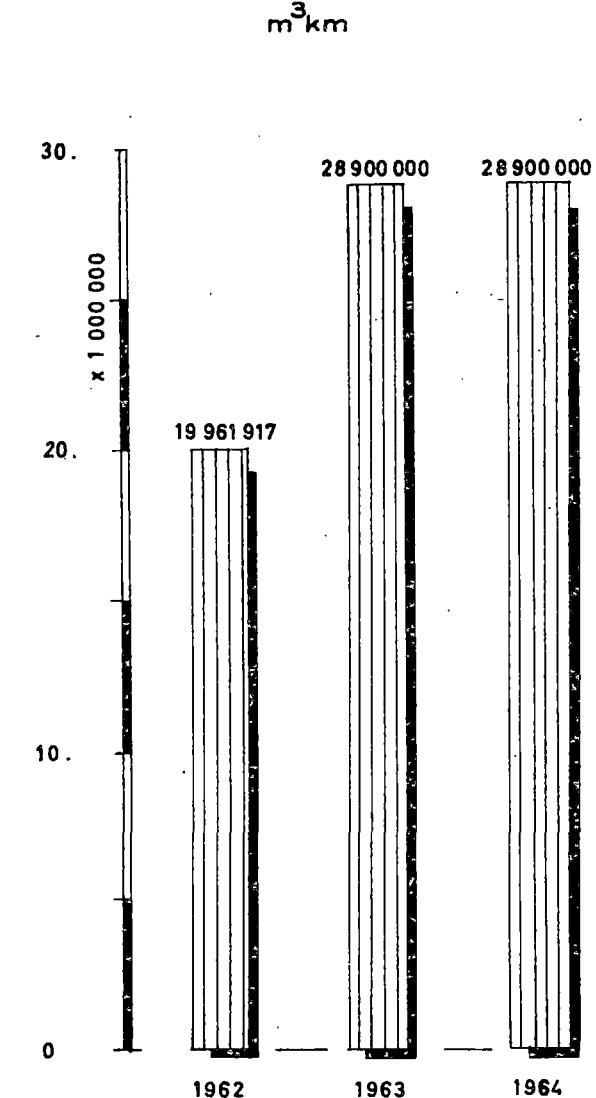

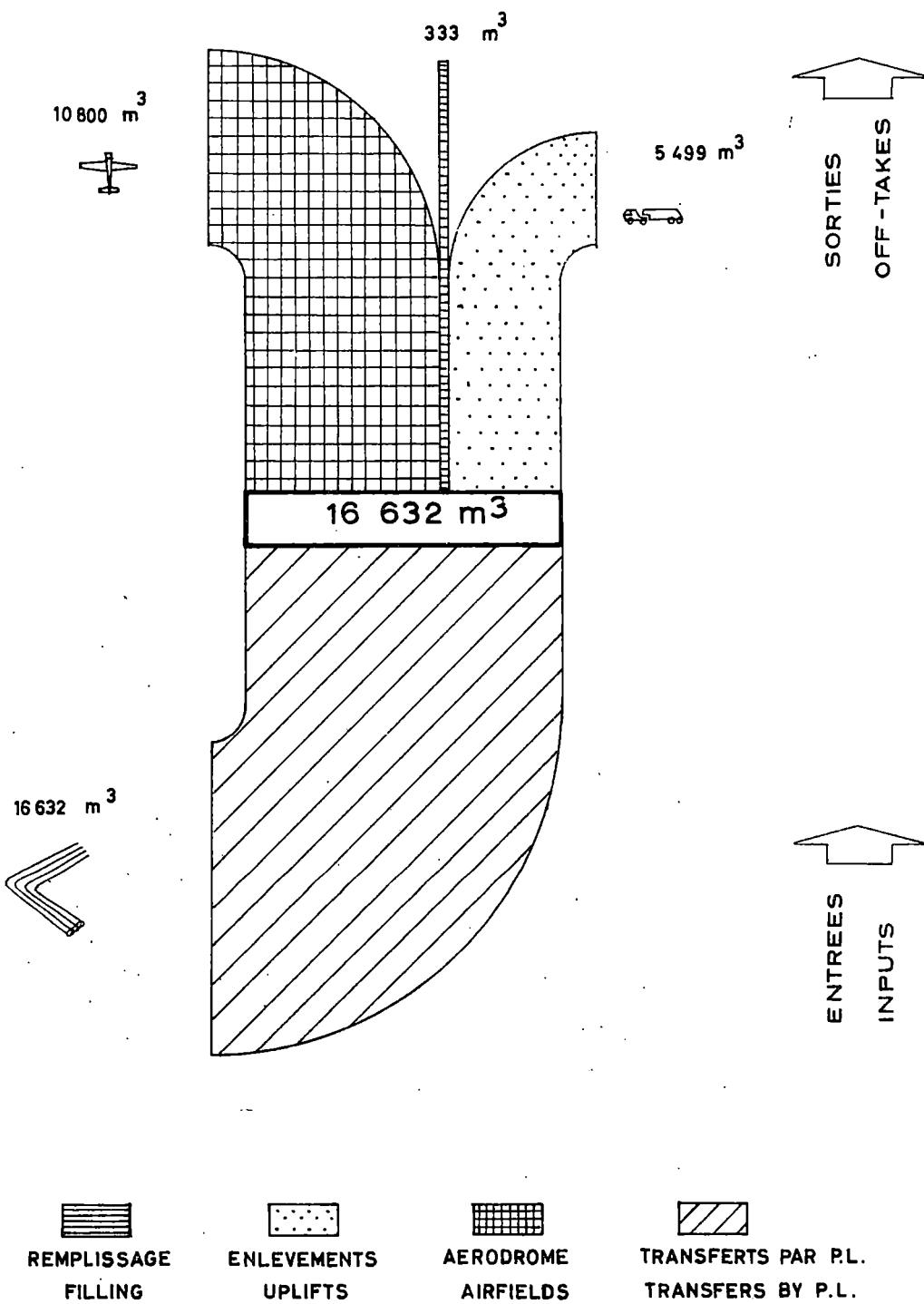

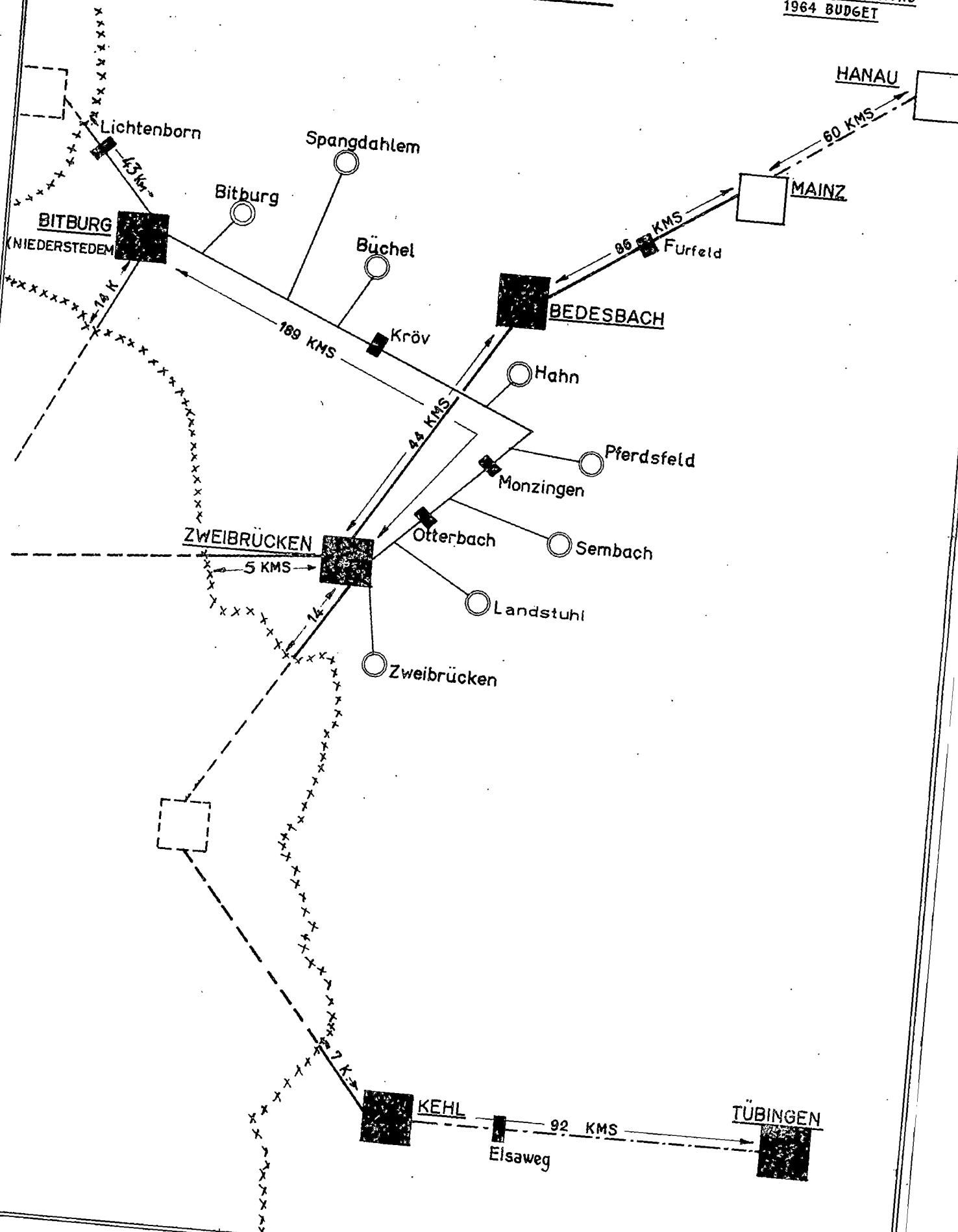
