Thank you for your letter, dated October 8, 1958, concerning the above estates.

The late Thomas Maracle died intestate on 14th November 1936 leaving him surviving as heirs at law his wife, Mary and his daughter Floretta Hill.

The sole land asset in his estate was property in the north half of Lot 21, Con. 2 (Tuss.) designated as parcel 6 on your sketch map of the entire lot.

A 1/3 interest in this property therefore, passed to the deceased's widow, Mary, and the other 2/3 interest passed to the deceased's daughter, Floretta Hill.

The only other asset in the estate was the sum of \$87.01 held in Savings Account 32-258. This money also passed in the ratio of a 1/3 interest - \$29.00 - to the deceased's widow, Mary, and a 2/3 interest - \$58.01 - to his daughter Floretta. Under separate cover we are arranging to send to Floretta Hill, care of your office, a cheque for \$58.01. Mary Maracle's \$29.00 share is being transferred to a separate Savings Account in the name of her estate.

The late Mary (Green) Maracle died intestate on 6th June 1950 leaving her surviving as heirs at law her daughter, Floretta Hill, and her son Peter (Hope) Maracle.

The first land asset in her estate was property in the south half of Lot 5, Con. 2 (Oneida) designated as parcel 5 on Location Ticket Sketch 121 which she held under Location Ticket 8483.

As the deceased had been maintained by the Council for some years and had been provided by the Council with the house which she used and as the Council had paid her funeral expenses amounting to \$55.00, this property thereby reverted to the Band. Its subsequent history is dealt with in the land file.

The second land asset in the estate was the 1/3 interest in parcel 6 in the north half of Lot 21, Con. 2 (Tusc.) which she had inherited from her husband, Thomas Maracle's estate as noted above.

This property passed in equal shares to the deceased's two children, Floretta Hill and Peter (Hope) Maracle.

By relinquishment dated October 7th, 1958 Peter Maracle signed off his interest in this property to Floretta Hill who thereby obtained possession of the whole of parcel 6 in the north half of Lot 21, Con. 2 (Tusc.).

We are therefore, requesting the officer in charge of Individual Land Holdings to issue to Floretta Hill, No. 343, Upper Mohawk Band a Certificate of Possession for this parcel 6.

The only other asset in the estate of Mary Maracle was her 1/3 share - \$29.00 - of the funds in her late husband's estate. This money, therefore, passes in equal shares to her two children, Peter Maracle and Floretta Hill i.e. \$14.50 each.

We are, therefore arranging to send to Floretta Hill and Peter Maracle, care of your office, cheques for \$14.50 each.

There do not appear to be any outstanding matters in these two estates and, therefore, when you have turned over the three cheques to the recipients and have received the Certificate of Possession for Floretta Hill would you please advise us so that we may note in our records the conclusion of this administration of the estates of Thomas Maracle and Mary Maracle.

Enclosed herewith is claim entered by Peter (Hope) Maracle against the above noted estates for the share of funds due him in the disposal of property from the estate of his grandmother, Elizabeth (Abram) Maracle. (file 9032-708).

Mr. Maracle was advised that a review of the related estates had been recently made in connection with these funds and that it would appear he is entitled to share along with his older half-sister, Floretta in the portion that would fall to their mother, Mary, as although Mary was separated from the late Thomas Maracle shortly after Floretta was born, she was still an heir and entitled to share with their daughter in the estate of Thomas Maracle, he having died intestate on November 14, 1936.

A review of the Agency membership records indicates that Mary Green was married to Thomas Maracle and was placed on the Band list with him under Lower Mohawk #490 on October 7, 1889. The daughter, Floretta, was born in 1891. In 1893 Mary separated from Thomas, the Band Interest payment on Lower Mohawk #490 was split Mary receiving her own separately. The daughter Floretta was paid on the ticket of her grandmother, Mrs. Abram Maracle, at that time, under Lower Mohawk #488. The illegitimate son, Peter, was born to Mrs. Maracle in 1894 and placed with Mrs. David Givens on Upper Mohawk #111. After the death of Mrs. Givens in 1909 Peter was returned to his mother and placed in 1911 under her number which was then Lower Mohawk #165. In the revision of the membership list the band number of Thomas Maracle had in the meantime been changed to Lower Mohawk #164. In June 1944 Peter Maracle was transferred to his own number, Lower Mohawk #512.

With regard to the previously reported estate of Mary Green (Maracle) on file 9032-1139, we would advise that as the Council had maintained the deceased for some years and provided the dwelling she used, they were entitled to claim the assets for this reason rather than under section 29 of the Indian Act. However, the Council was apparently not aware that there were children and a casual check of the files would not disclose that fact. In any event, the Council claim was satisfied and no further record of their account is on record.

As Peter Maracle is now an elderly person of 64 years and an invalid partially blind, he is receiving a disability pension. He has a home with Mr. and Mrs. George Johnson of R.R. 1, Hagersville, Ont. and is well provided for. He has no need for any real estate and the fractional interest that he might have in any land does not interest him.

With the above particulars in mind the enclosed relinquishment of all further claim in consideration of his rightful share of 1/2 of his mother's cash assets is eminently reasonable and we would recommend the approval of same.

In view of the above it therefore follows that Floretta Maracle Hill, the only child of Thomas Maracle is entitled to a 2/3 interest in her father's estate and to 1/2 of the share falling to her mother, Mary, who died on May 6, 1950. May the necessary action kindly be taken to release to Mrs. Floretta Hill and to Peter Maracle their shares of the funds held in Savings account #32-258 to the credit of the Thomas Maracle estate and also the issue of Certificate of Possession to Floretta Hill, Upper Mohawk #343 for parcel #6 in the north half of Lot 21, Concession 2, Tuscarora.

The late Elizabeth Maracle died testate in approximately 1930.

Included among the land assets of her estate was property in the North half of Lot 22, Con. 1, (Tase.) shown as Parcel 2 on the sketch-map of the lot. This approximate 12 1/2 acre property had been inherited by Mrs. Maracle from the estate of her late husband Abreu Maracle (Estate file 9032-273 - concluded).

By her will dated 5th August, 1935, Elizabeth Maracle devised this property equally between her son, Thomas Maracle and Christine Douglas. The property was subsequently put up for sale and sold to Mrs. James Smith for \$150.00.

Mrs. Smith died intestate in September 5th, 1940, (estate file 9032-1453 - concluded).

At the time of her death Mrs. Smith had not completed the payments on the property and her husband, James Smith, paid off the balance owing thereby obtaining the property.

The property is now included in the land assets of the estate of James Smith which is dealt with on file 9032-1582.

The \$150.00 from the sale of the property was used to pay off a land loan against the estate and the balance of the funds have been divided equally between the estates of Thomas Maracle and Christine Douglas according to the provisions of the deceased's will.

The sum of \$87.01 has been placed in Savings Account 32-258 in the name of the estate of Thomas Maracle and this will be further dealt with on estate file 9032-679.

Enclosed herewith please find the application for administration of the estate of Thomas Maracle, Lower Mohawk #164, who died intestate on November 14, 1936.

Heirs at Law and next of kin are his wife, Mary and daughter Floretta. Mary, who had separated from Thomas in 1893 and was transferred to her own no. (later Lower Mohawk #165) died intestate on May 6, 1950. Floretta Maracle Hill Upper Mohawk #343 is still living but is in her 71st year and in very poor health. She has several times requested that her claim be considered and at least a portion of the funds owing her father be released to her.

The assets of this estate are a part of the funds paid over by Ida and Jonas Smith in the purchase of 12½ acres in the north half of Lot 22, Concession 1, Tuscarora from the Elizabeth (Abram) Maracle estate, file 9032-708. These funds are held in Department savings account #32-42 and with interest to May 1, 1957 amount to \$168.95. There is also the 30 acres more or less in the north half of Lot 21, Concession 2, Tuscarora from the same estate, reference Agency letter of May 6, 1958 on file 32/33B-21N-2-Tuscarora.


