Dear Comrades,

We would like to make a further explanation of a circular
request a thinking on how to operate the convention travel costs
for this years Provincial Convention, October 1961.

On the basis of 1955 M.A. payments and 1960 we are setting in
your clubs, and assuming that Provincial Committee members will
have voice and vote in the Convention and therefore will have to
be treated with delegate status, so in your total delegation
will work out like this:

Colman - 2 delegates plus 1 Provincial Committee member
Lethbridge - 3 delegates
Drumheller - 2 delegates
Calgary city - 6 delegates, plus 3 Prov. Comm. members

The aim in setting up the Convention Fund is to cover the total
travel costs of the above comrades. This, of course, requires that
all clubs pay into the fund as outlined in the enclosed circular at
the rates stated. In establishing the rate, we worked costs on the
basis of car-travel. We used the following schedule for your clubs:

Colman - 1 car with expenses of \$24.00 for return trip,
Lethbridge - 1 car with return costs of \$18.00
Calgary - 2 cars with \$12.00 return costs for each.
Drumheller - we hoped would join delegates in Calgary
and we would allow for our travel from
Drum to Calgary.

The four cars that are covered by the travel costs refund
will be able to bring a maximum of 24 comrades, of which 17 have
delegate status. This allows for extra comrades from clubs who
could be asked to contribute nominally to gas and oil expenses. If
enough of the club comrades want to make the trip, we will be pre-
pared to include the allowance for one more car in the convention
refund.

Would you comrades discuss it on this basis and please write
the Provincial Office on it? Could you now plan by arranging for the
cars, going ahead immediately with the election of your delegates,
canvassing other club comrades to attend the convention, etc.
