Enclosed you will find a list of pupils from Father Moss Separate School who possess either head lice (pediculosis), possibly scabies, abcessed ears, a rash, warts, or sores covering parts of their body.

As principal teacher of this school, I am most concerned with the physical condition of many of my pupils. It is quite difficult teaching these students when they are suffering from these health problems. At the same time I am aware that my role as educator does not compel me to become too involved in the mechanics of health in as they exist on the domestic scene. However, since I am deeply interested in the education aspect of the 216 pupils, I have gone to the effort of checking into this situation more thoroughly than I believe my role compels.

On April 18, 1973, Mrs. Carol Morris, Mr. Francis Kavanaugh and I, entered every classroom. Mrs. Carol Morris attempted to locate the medical problems of the pupils, while Mr. Francis Kavanaugh jotted down her comments. I was present in order that I might be aware of all proceedings.








These aforementioned facts strongly suggest that Father Moss School have better access to a nurse than presently exists. I am most pleased with the interest that Mrs. Gloria Meckley, Public Health Nurse, Northwestern Health Unit, has shown as she visits our school every Friday morning; however, I hope that the above named pupils will clarify my wish for a nurse who could spend much more time than her schedule permits.

She (this nurse) would almost have to be available for a certain number of hours every week and equally important have the necessary medical supplies required for the performance of her duties, (if she performed any duties beyond an assessment role).

Our school, as it exists as of this writing, fails to present the necessary health room and supplies required for such a desired nurse. Her understanding of this situation would facilitate her daily duties.


Dear Sirs:

Further to your phone call of November 15th and Mrs. Johnston's visit of the 17th, I am forwarding my appraisal of the situation for your information.

1. Gym Equipment:

We will forward a purchase order to cover (a) 13 girls at \$8.00 each
(b) 12 boys at \$5.00 each

Please purchase the supplies for the students and submit a bill either through the Board or your school which does not exceed the total.

2. Bus Trip:

If the Board gives to the students as a whole (Indian and non-Indian) we will be billed through the normal method of tuition billing for our students. I would prefer to have it done this way rather than by a special or separate donation. We have not been able to find a separate billing for last year so it must have been handled this way before. Since you are planning such a costly trip I would require a letter outlining costs involved for each student and other contributions being made by or for each individual before I could reach a decision. *on any other method of payment*

3. Christmas Gifts

I understand moneys were given the first 3 or 4 years. Father Moss School was in operation but was discontinued in recent years. There is no record in our files of this having been done and as you are aware there is no program to make gifts available to Indian students in either the federal or provincial schools. If, however, the Board makes this part of their regular program for all students, we will pay it through tuitions as we do for all operational costs of the board.
