Dear Marcel:

I thought you might be interested in the attached telegram which we received last week from Laos. The two students are being brought to Canada for a three-year diploma course in agricultural technology. For the first year they will be at the Agricultural School at St.-Martin, Quebec, and for the remaining two years they will be at the Institute of Technology at Ste Anne de la Pocatiere, which is affiliated with Laval University.

It may be that Msgr. Lussier's interest in the students stems entirely from a personal desire to be helpful to them in any way that he can during their stay in Canada. On the other hand, because of his special relationship with the Ministry of Education in the Province of Quebec, it may go beyond a personal desire to help and he may have taken this opportunity to imply a provincial government participation in the training program.
