I arrived here in Canada June 10th 1939 and got Canadian Citizenship in November 1944.

Samuel Eckstein left Paris, France, the day that the Germans occupied that country.

June 18th 1940, he bought 50 common shares from the International Nickel Company of Canada Limited, certificates MJ87549/53 for 10 shares each of the common stock registered under the name of Fernand Rase.

Mr. Eckstein, having made adjustments with me, has offered these shares to me as a repayment and adjustment between us.

Mr. Eckstein arrived in Mexico City, where he is established, at the end of 1940. He is a Polish citizen and may now become a Mexican Citizen.

He possessed these 50 nickel shares from that date until now and on his latest visit to Canada, he left these shares with me.

I am now considering selling these shares and would ask you to please be kind enough to permit me to sell these shares and also to let me have the accumulated interest since 1940.

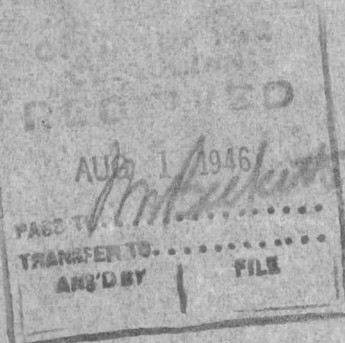

The new owner of these shares will be known to you, one day or another, either by the dividend checks or by the sale when the quotation will be resumed in France.

I would be very grateful if you would let me know whether there is any form whatsoever to be filled out. I will then continue my investigation in order to find out who the purchaser is and to meet him if possible.

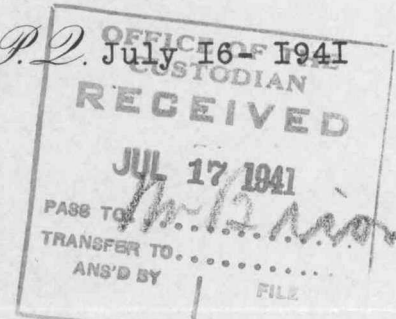

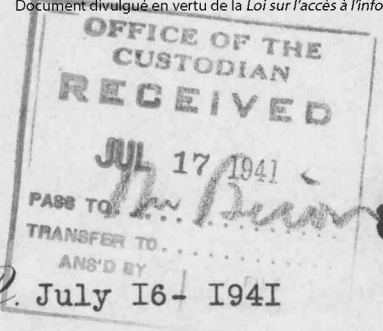
